JRO has grown steadily from a small string orchestra to a full symphonic ensemble made up of over 90 members. Members receive group and individual coaching, enabling them to build solid, fundamental technical and musical skills. JRO performs five times during the year at several venues throughout the Boston area, including Symphony Hall, Boston University's Tsai Performance Center and Sanders Theatre at Harvard University.

Adrian Slywotzky

Adrian Slywotzky began conducting with BYSO in the 2005-2006 season and is also an alumnus of BYSO. He currently serves as Director of Instrumental Music at Hopkins School, and maintains a studio of violin and viola students at the Neighborhood Music School in New Haven, CT. Adrian holds a Master of Music from the Yale School of Music and a Bachelor of Arts from Yale College, where he directed the Jonathan Edwards Chamber Players and the Berkeley College Orchestra.

Boston Youth Symphony Orchestras
